

New Balance High Five Race 2025 Regulations

I. Organizer

1. The Organizer of the New Balance High Five Race 2025 is the „Marathon Warsaw” Foundation; Brylantowa Street 15, 05-077 Warsaw, NIP 9521913280, REGON 015438288.
2. Contact with the Organizer, including filing a complaint, is available via phone: (+48) 503 860 516, by email: info@warsawmarathon.com or by mail to the address: Fundacja „Maraton Warszawski”, Murmańska 25, 04-204 Warsaw, Poland.

II. Date and place

1. The run will take place on the 30th of March 2025 in Warsaw.
2. The race will start at 9:30 AM. The start may be wave-based. The starting line will be closed after around 5 minutes from the start of the last group.
3. Length of the route: 5 km. The route has PZLA and World Athletics certification. Note! The route does not meet the World Athletics criterion regarding the difference in altitude above sea level between the start and finish lines, which is significant for registering significant sports achievements.
4. The exact route of the Race will be announced on the website polmaratonwarszawski.com. The Organizer reserves the right to change the route, informing the Participants by posting a new route on the website www.polmaratonwarszawski.com. Such a change does not result in any additional claims or obligations.
5. The route will be marked with vertical and horizontal signs every 1 kilometer.
6. The Organizer reserves the right to change the start time, informing the Participants by posting relevant information on the website polmaratonwarszawski.com. Such a change does not result in any additional claims or obligations.

III. Time limit

1. Participants are subject to a time limit of 45 minutes, which, in the case of a wave start, is counted from the last start signal.
2. Participants who do not complete the Race within the specified time limit are obliged to forfeit the Race and leave the route.
3. Participants remaining on the route after the specified time limit do so at their own risk and responsibility, in accordance with the road traffic Regulations and the Civil Code.

IV. Participation

1. The right to participate in the Race is granted to individuals who will turn 15 by the 30th of March, 2025 (DOB before the 30th of March 2010). Possibility of participation for individuals who will turn 13 by the 30th of March 2024 (DOB before the 30th of March 2012) upon presentation of a medical certificate allowing participation in the Race. Medical certificates must be sent to the Organizer via email to info@maratonwarszawski.com before the 16th of March 2025 and provided in-person at the Race Office when picking up the Race Kit.
2. All Race Participants must be verified at the Race Office. Verification can be done:
 - i. in person – based on a photo ID and a personalised QR code.
 - ii. by an authorized person – based on a personalised QR code of the Participant and a photo or photocopy of the Participant’s ID.

QR codes will be sent to the Participants via email and text message on the 27th of March 2025 around 5 pm.

Race office opening hours will be announced at a later time.

Note! On Race day, the Race Office will be closed and the Race Kit collection will be impossible.

4. Every underage Participant of the Race, at the time of receiving the Race kit, must present an ID (we accept a student ID card) and a „Declaration of Parent or Legal Guardian about the child’s ability to participate in recreational sports activities” signed by a parent or legal guardian. The aforementioned document can be downloaded from the Runner’s Panel. Failure to present the above document

prevents proper verification at the Race Office, and thus participation in the Race. Participants above 13 and under 15 years of age (DOB between 31th of March 2010 and 30th of March 2012) must also provide a written consent of a sports medicine physician to be allowed to participate in the Race.

5. If a parent or authorized person reports to collect the Race Pack for an underage Participant, they must present the personalised QR code and a declaration from the Parent or Guardian mentioned in the point above, as well as a photo or photocopy of the Participant's ID. For Participants above 13 and under 15 years of age (DOB between 31th of March 2010 and 30th of March 2012) a written consent of a sports medicine physician must also be presented at the Race Office.
6. In the Race Office, every Participant will receive an individual Race Kit with, among others, a starting number, timing chip (integrated with the starting number), safety pins, deposit bag and keepsake T-shirt (optional, according to the selected option of Race Kit). T-shirts in the Race office will be distributed pursuant to the previous declaration of Participants. T-shirt size shall be chosen in the application form. Change in the size will be possible in the application form but not later than on 14th of March 2025. The number of T-shirts in each size is limited and the availability of each size is not guaranteed.
7. Race Kits not collected in the Race Office will be neither sent nor distributed in any other way at a later date.
8. During the Race, all Participants shall have their starting number horizontally attached to the front of their Race tops (alternatively, sweatshirt or jacket). The starting number shall be visible during the whole Race. Covering (in part or in whole during the whole Race or its part) or modification of the starting number is forbidden under the penalty of disqualification. The timing chip is integrated with the starting number. Tampering with the timing chip (folding, unsticking, etc.) or placing the bib number in a place other than horizontally in front of the chest may result in the timing chip not working properly and, therefore, no result being recorded.
9. Participation with a starting number other than your own is forbidden and will result in a disqualification of the Participant registered with the starting number used.
10. The Organizer allows the start of Participants on wheelchairs with direct manual drive. After filling in the application form where they declare the will to start on a wheelchair, the Participant shall send an email to info@warsawmarathon.com with a document proving their disability attached – it is a condition for granting a 50% discount of the entry fee (Race kit without T-shirt). It is not allowed to start on wheelchairs: with indirect drive (e.g. handbike) or rim-push type. Participants on wheelchairs must complete the entire course of the Race on their own, without the help of others.
11. Race Participants are subject to PZLA, World Athletics Regulations, and these Regulations.
12. According to the PZLA guidelines, Participants representing Russia and Belarus are excluded from participation in the 19th Warsaw Half Marathon. The exceptions are Participants of Belarusian nationality who permanently reside in Poland and will send a scan of the [DECLARATION](#) to info@warsawmarathon.com. These Participants start without representing any country. If the individual does not provide the Declaration, they will not be allowed to participate in the Race, and the entry fee will not be returned.
13. Participants representing Russia and Belarus who, while registering, will deliberately declare a nationality different than their own will not be allowed to participate and the entry fee will not be returned.
14. The Organizer provides medical care on the starting line, along the Racecourse and on the finish line.

V. Registrations

1. Registrations are accepted through the registration form available on the websites: polmaratonwarszawski.com and <https://rejestracja.maratonwarszawski.com/>.
2. Registration is considered to be complete when following conditions are met: application form is filled in and the entry fee payment is credited to Organizer's account.
3. To participate in the New Balance High Five Race, you can register by choosing one of two paths:
 - i. traditional – by filling out the registration form available on the event website and paying the standard registration fee.
 - ii. charitable – by participating in the #IRunWell campaign, regulated in Appendix 1 of these Regulations.
4. Registration will be carried out in the following stages:
 - i. from 2nd of December 2024 to 16th of March 2025 – open registration in the traditional and charity path;
 - ii. from 17th of March 2025 to 29th of March 2025 – open registration only in the traditional path.

5. Online registrations will be closed on the 29th of March 2024 at 8pm. Signing up for the Race will also be possible in person at the Race Office of the New Balance High Five Race, with the reservation that the total pool of start numbers for people registering after the 27th of March 2025 and available at the Race Office is 200.
6. The Participant limit for the New Balance High Five Race is 6,500 people. The Organizer reserves the right to change this limit.
7. The Organizer reserves the right to close registrations earlier in case the Participant limits indicated in point V.6 are exhausted.

VI. **Shipping the Race Kit**

1. The Participants of the New Balance High Five Race 2024 may use the option of Race Kit shipment.
2. The shipment of the Race Kit means shipping a package containing the Race Kit via DHL Parcel Polska Sp. z o.o. <http://www.dhl.com/pl-pl> to the address indicated by the Participant, on the terms set out in the Regulations for the provision of domestic shipping and postal services by DHL Parcel Polska Sp. z o. o.
3. The shipment of the Race Kit is available only in Poland.
4. The shipment of the Race Kit includes shipping of the starting number, timing chip (integrated with the starting number), safety pins and a commemorative T-shirt – according to the selected Race Kit option). Additional marketing freebies provided by the Event’s sponsors are not included in the shipment of the Race Kit. Those will only be distributed when picking up the Race Kit in the Race Office.
5. The shipment of the Race Kit is an additional fee option. The fee for sending a Race Kit is PLN 35 / EUR 10 (gross) for one Participant. Race kits are sent individually, and it is impossible to send more than one Race Kit in a single shipment.
6. Ordering and paying the option of shipping the Race Kit is possible until the 10th of March 2025.
7. The condition for shipping the Race Kit is having a starting number (sent after the entry fee is credited) not later than on the 10th of March 2025.
8. The shipments will take place about two weeks before the Race. In the event of not receiving the delivery until the 25th of March 2025, the Participant shall report this fact to the Organizer at info@maratonwarszawski.com.
9. The Participant using the shipment option is not required to be verified at the Race Office.

VII. **Fees**

1. Each Participant of the New Balance High Five Race 2025 bears the cost of the entry fee. The exception is the Participants of the #IRunWell charity program, who are subject to the procedure described in Appendix 1 of these Regulations. The starting fee consists of the starting package (point IV. 6. of the Regulations), as well as service for the competitor before, during and after the competition, rental and/or purchase of infrastructure necessary to organize the run, as well as maintenance of the online competition registration website and the competition website.

The registration fee rates for foreigners are:

3. The Participant also has the possibility to order additional options and services, the prices of which are:

4. The number of T-shirts is limited. If a Participant has chosen in the application form a T-shirt but did not pay the fee within 7 days of registering and the number of available T-shirts is low, the Organizer reserves the right to delete selected (unpaid) T-shirts from the registration form.
5. If the payment is made in an insufficient amount (e.g. as a result of exceeding the deadlines listed in the Regulations), the remaining difference to the amount of the applicable entry fee according to the date of the last transfer must be paid by the Participant - the final payment of the entry fee must be made in accordance with the entry fee at the time of the payment.
6. For Participants starting on wheelchairs, the Organizer grants a discount on the entry fee in the amount of 50% of the basic entry fee (kit without T-shirt) applicable at the time of entry fee settlement. The obligatory condition is to email info@warsawmarathon.com with the document proving disability attached.
7. Entry fee may be settled by online payment (from the application profile) via <https://www.payu.pl/> PayU S.A. is responsible for the settlement and safety of transactions, with the registered office in Poznań, 60-166 Poznań, at ul. Grunwaldzka 182, having tax identification number NIP: 7792308495, REGON 300523444, a domestic payment institution supervised by the Polish Financial Supervision Authority, entered into the Payment Services Register under number IP1/2012. PayU REGULATIONS.
8. As soon as the entry fee is credited to the bank account of the Organizer a Race number will appear on the start list at <https://polmaratonwarszawski.com/> next to the Participant's name. If the starting number does not appear within 7 days from the day of the money transfer, the Participant is obliged to contact the Organizer via (+48 22) 266 21 00 or info@warsawmarathon.com
9. The Organizer is not liable for the loss of a registration form, money order or bank transfer by the fault of the post office or a bank.
10. Based on Article 38 point 12 of the Act on Consumer Rights (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 287), Participants who are consumers within the meaning of Article 221 of the Polish Civil Code, have no right to withdraw from the contract.
11. The entry fee, once paid is non-refundable, non-transferable to another Participant, non-transferable to another event organized by the Warsaw Marathon Foundation and non-transferable onto a voucher.
12. During registration, Participants have the possibility to order and pay an additional option: „Possibility of resignation from start and cash-back”. In that case, the Participant has the option to resign from taking part in the Race without a reason and receive a 100% refund of the paid entry fee (including additional options). The condition for using the purchased option is to notify the will to resign from the start no later than the 27th of March 2025 (in the case of collecting the Race Kit at the Race Office) or by the 13th of March 2025 (in the case of using the shipping of Race Kit option). The cost of the service is PLN 25 / EUR 7 and is non-refundable (also in the case of resignation from the start).
13. Resignation indicated in point VII. 12. should be made by log-in into the Participant's account on the <https://rejestracja.maratonwarszawski.com/> and selecting the “Resign from Race” button in the YOUR EVENTS tab.
14. Refund indicated in point VII. 12 covering full amount of the entry fee and the purchased additional services (except for the „Possibility of resignation from start and cash-back”) will be made within 21 days, using the same payment method as the fee was paid. Refunds shall not apply to entry fees paid using the “promotional code”.
15. Participants who want to receive an invoice for the paid starting fee should select the appropriate option in the registration form and enter the required data needed to issue the document. The invoice will be generated automatically after the payment has been credited and will be made available for downloading from the Participant's profile by the 15th day of the month following the month in which the payment took place.
16. In accordance with tax Regulations, due to making a payment before the service is performed, an advance payment invoice will be issued covering the full amount of the payment made. Thus, the advance payment invoice is also the final invoice.

17. By selecting the Invoice option, the Participant agrees to send/share invoices in electronic form without the recipient's signature. This consent does not exclude the Organizer's right to issue and send invoices in paper form.
18. To receive a pro forma invoice, please send: the invoice data, the number and the list of Participants (with the registration numbers) together with the information about the chosen option of the Race Kit to ksiegowosc@maratonwarszawski.com. Pro forma invoices are issued for the participation of at least two Participants (there is no possibility of receiving a pro forma invoice for the participation of a single person)

VIII. Deposits, refreshment points

1. Participants will receive a special deposit bag in the Race Kit, allowing them to leave their deposit in a special deposit area. The deposits will be given back only on the basis of the starting number. In case of a lost starting number, the Organizer is discharged from any liability for giving the deposit to someone else. Note! It is forbidden to leave valuable objects and documents in the deposit.
2. Participants will have the option to use changing rooms and deposit points before and after the Race.
3. Participants have the possibility to use refreshment points along the course and to receive a water after the finish line

IX. Checkpoints

1. On the Race route, there will be timing checkpoints.
2. The staff at the timing checkpoints will record the Race numbers of Participants who deviate from the route. Participants who shorten or change the route will be disqualified.

X. Classification and Results

1. During the New Balance High Five Race 2025, the following classifications will be conducted:
 - i. Overall Classification
 - ii. Overall Women's / Men's Classification
 - iii. Classification of wheelchair athletes (these athletes are excluded from other classifications)
2. The basis of classification is electronic timing. There will be checkpoint mats along the course that record the Participant's presence at each point. Failure to register the Participant's presence at a checkpoint may result in disqualification.
3. The overall classification is based on actual times (net times – measured from crossing the start line). An exception is made for the first 50 individuals crossing the finish line – they are classified based on official times (gross times – from the starter's shot), with the provision that if among the first 50 finishers there are fewer than 3 men and 3 women, the number of individuals classified in this manner will be increased accordingly.
4. In the final Race results, each Participant receives information about both gross and net times.
5. The unofficial Race results will be posted on the polmaratonwarszawski.com website immediately after the Race.
6. Written protests regarding the results will be accepted until the 1st of April 2025, at 6:00 PM CET at the email address info@maratonwarszawski.com. Protests will be reviewed within 96 hours, and the final official results will be published no later than the 14th of April 2025.
7. The certificate of completion for the New Balance High Five Race will be available for self-printing on the website polmaratonwarszawski.com no later than 21 days after the event.
8. The Organizer reserves the right to introduce additional classifications.

XI. Prizes

1. All Participants who complete the New Balance High Five Race receive commemorative medals at the finish line.
2. The winners of first through third place in the overall classifications for both women and men will receive commemorative trophies.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to sponsor additional cash and in-kind prizes in selected categories and classifications of their choice.

XII. Personal data protection

1. The personal data of Participants will be processed in accordance with applicable Regulations, in particular with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

2. The processing of data referred to in point XI. 1. also includes the publication of: first name, last name, year of birth, name of the locality, and name of the club.
3. Detailed information regarding the processing of personal data is included in Appendix 2 to this Regulation.

XIII. Final provisions

1. Remaining on the New Balance High Five Race route without a valid bib number is not allowed. Individuals without a valid bib number will be removed from the route by event staff. Specifically, it is prohibited to travel on the Race route using bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, other mechanical devices, and baby strollers (without valid permission issued by the Organizer). The use of Nordic walking poles and running with a dog is also prohibited. Only vehicles of the Organizer (bicycles, motorcycles, cars) with a valid pass issued by the Organizer may be present on the route.
2. To obtain individual consent to participate with a baby stroller, the Participant should send a scan of the DECLARATION to the address info@maratonwarszawski.com and deliver its original copy to the Race Office during the Race packet pick-up.
3. During the Race, Participants must adhere to the instructions issued by safety personnel, security services, and other individuals designated by the Organizer. Failure to comply with instructions may result in disqualification.
4. The Organizer provides each Participant with personal accident insurance for the duration of the Race (insured up to PLN 5,000).
5. Every Participant is obliged to get acquainted with the rules and Regulations of the Race and accept them. By accepting the Regulations the Participant agrees to receive first aid by medical and paramedical services and for medical treatment and the transportation of the Participant to safe place in case of emergency by services approved by the Organizer.
6. The Participant declares that they are able to take part in the Race and that they have no knowledge of any reasons connected with their state of health that could exclude them from participation in the Race and that they take part in the Race on their own responsibility. The Participant notes that participating in the run is connected with physical effort, natural risk of accident, body injury and physical trauma (including death) and material loss. Additionally, other unforeseeable risks can occur. Accepting the terms and conditions of the Regulations and rules of the Race means that the Participant considered all the risks connected with the run and will start the run on their own responsibility. All the decisions made by medical service during the Race about the continuation of the Race by the Participant are final and binding.
7. After the Race, random doping controls will be conducted, and the Participant designated by the Commission must absolutely submit to them.
8. By registering to participate in the competition, the Participant accepts this Regulation and agrees to the free use of their image captured in the form of photographs or video recordings. The Participant also grants the Organizer a royalty-free license to use their image in all fields of exploitation, including: recording and dissemination in any form, storing in computer memory, use for promotion and organization of events by the „Warsaw Marathon” Foundation, sharing with sponsors and partners of the New Balance High Five Race 2025 for promotional purposes related to their participation in the event, inclusion and publication in publications of the „Warsaw Marathon” Foundation, on promotional materials printed by the Organizer, in the press, on websites, and in television and radio broadcasts.
9. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel, postpone or stop the Race without justification.
10. Placing advertising materials on Race infrastructure elements (e.g., fences, gates, etc.) is the exclusive right of the Organizer and is reserved specifically for official sponsors/partners of the Race. It is prohibited to place any advertising media on the Race route or in the areas used for Race organization (e.g., finish line area, Race village) without the Organizer’s consent.
11. The binding and final interpretation of this Regulation is solely the prerogative of the Organizer of the New Balance High Five Race. Matters not covered in the Regulation are resolved by the Organizer. If any provision of the Regulation is deemed partially or wholly invalid or unenforceable, all other provisions (wholly or partially) remain valid.
12. Participants of the Race and individuals present at the event are prohibited from engaging in behavior inciting violence or displaying symbols encouraging aggression or supporting military

actions. Persons violating this prohibition will be removed from the Race route and event premises.

Who is the administrator of your personal data?

For what purpose and on what basis are your personal data processed?

1. Rendering electronic services:
 - Execution of the contract – meaning your participation in the Race
2. Execution of the contract – meaning your participation in the Race:
 - Your participation in the Races for which you register through the registration.maratonwarszawski.com website (preparation of the Race packet, insurance, result processing, award issuance, etc.)
 - publishing publicly available start lists and results
 - providing payment services
 - sending organizational information (email / SMS) about the Races for which you register through the registration.maratonwarszawski.com website
 - handling registrations and correspondence directed to us by you
 - contacting you
 - facilitating contact with a charitable organization supported by you (in case of charitable registration #BiegamDobrze)
3. fulfillment of legal obligations incumbent on the „Warsaw Marathon” Foundation
 - for tax and accounting purposes
4. for purposes arising from the legitimate interests pursued by the „Warsaw Marathon” Foundation
 - conducting direct marketing of products and services
 - handling registrations and correspondence directed to us by you
 - contacting you
 - preventing fraud and abuse
5. based on your consent provided:
 - sending marketing information (email / SMS)

Do you need to provide personal data?

Providing personal data is necessary both for your participation in the Race and for managing your account on the registration.maratonwarszawski.com website.

Failure to provide personal data makes it impossible to conclude a contract and participate in the Race.

How long will your personal data be processed?

Your data will be processed for the duration of using the registration.maratonwarszawski.com website and participating in the Races for which you register through the Website.

After this period, your data will continue to be stored for purposes arising from legal provisions (especially tax and accounting), as well as for fraud prevention and abuse prevention, and pursuing any claims arising from the concluded contract.

Some of your data (especially those contained in Race results) may also be processed after this deadline for statistical and archival purposes.

Who will be the recipient of personal data?

Your personal data will be disclosed to employees, associates, and subcontractors of the Administrator to the extent necessary for the implementation of the aforementioned purposes of personal data processing.

Start lists and results containing basic personal data will be publicly available, including being published on the Race website.

What rights do you have regarding the processing of your personal data?

You have the right to request: access to your personal data, their rectification, their deletion, and limitation of their processing. You also have the right to object to their processing and to data portability.

Additionally, with regard to processing based on your consent – you have the right to withdraw it at any time.

To whom can you lodge a complaint about the processing of your personal data?

You can lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority: President of the Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.

Regulations of the #IRunWell Campaign

1. Participants, at the time of registration for the Race, are required to choose one of the available registration options:
 1. Traditional registration – by filling out the registration form available on the event's website and paying the required entry fee.
 2. Charity – by participating in the #IRunWell campaign, which is governed by these Regulations
2. To participate in the #IRunWell campaign, you need to:
 1. select the "charity registration path" in the Race registration form
 2. select a charitable cause to which the collected funds will be donated. You can choose from 11 available charitable organizations: Rak'n'Roll Foundation – Win Your Life, Amnesty International Association, Give Children Strength Foundation, Synapsis Foundation, Premature Foundation – Parents to Parents, Spartans for Children Foundation, Polish Humanitarian Action, Foundation "For the Rescue of Children with Cancer," DKMS Foundation, Faces of Depression Foundation, Avalon Foundation
 3. complete the required information on the fundraising profile (the page that will be visible to all users on the website and through which support for the fundraising campaign can be provided).
 4. complete the standard Race registration form (declared time, additional classifications, etc.)
3. After completing the registration, the Participant receives an email with a link to their individual page – the fundraising profile.
4. Participants who collect at least 250.00 PLN in their fundraising account by the 16th of March 2025, will be assigned a starting number for the New Balance High Five Race 2025. The cost of participation is covered by the supported charitable organization.
5. The start number obtained in this way, along with the charity starter pack for the New Balance High Five Race 2025, is non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another Participant or another Race.
6. Fundraising campaigns for individuals who have not collected the specified amount by the 16th of March 2025, will end on that date, and the funds raised will be distributed according to point 8 of these Regulations.
7. Fundraising campaigns for individuals who have collected the amount specified in point 4 of the Regulations (or exceeded it) will continue until the 11th of April 2025.

8. The collected funds, after deducting costs and fees (related to online payments), are distributed:
 1. 90% of the collected amount is transferred to the account of the chosen charitable organization
 2. 10% of the collected amount is allocated for the maintenance and development of the #IRunWell initiative and the statutory objectives of the Warsaw Marathon Foundation.

This distribution occurs regardless of the amount raised and whether the goal specified in point 4 has been achieved.

9. By registering for the #IRunWell initiative, the Participant agrees to transfer the funds they have raised to the account of the charitable organization of their choice, in accordance with point 8 of the Regulations.
10. Before fundraising the minimum of 250.00 PLN, the Participant can withdraw from continuing the fundraising and transfer their registration from the "charity path" to the "traditional path" by selecting the appropriate option in their profile on the website <https://rejestracja.maratonwarszawski.com/>. The funds collected up to that point will be transferred to the designated organization, in accordance with point 8.
